NOTE: Attorneys are required to attend hearings. If any attorney wishes to continue a scheduled Sentence Review Hearing, he/she must contact this office no later than 10 days after receipt of the Hearing Notice. If this office is not contacted in a timely fashion, a Sentence Review Hearing will not be continued (barring any emergencies that may arise).

If an attorney wishes to meet with their client, arrangements should be made to do so **prior** to the hearing date.

Each party is allotted **15 minutes** for presentation of their case. If more time is required, please notify the clerk of the board prior to the hearing. In such presentation, counsel should not repeat what was said at the Sentencing Hearing since members of the Board have reviewed the sentencing record.
